Under the impetus of Jean Sébastien Robicquet (distiller and founder of Maison Villevert), the distillery has set itself great ambitions: to become the benchmark for French whisky while developing both its Breton footprint and its Celtic roots.

Located by the sea, in Pleubian, in a unique environment facing the Island of Bréhat, Celtic Whisky Distillerie produces whiskies in the purest artisanal tradition.

Northern Brittany's wind and climate give the whiskies produced by the distillery a unique identity.

The distillery has gone one step further with Gwalarn, whose concept is to create a whisky with a French soul and Celtic roots.

Gwalarn is the world's first premium Celtic blend. It is produced in France to high-quality standards and an identical spirit to the prestigious single malts created by Celtic Whisky Distillerie.

For this unique blend, Jean Sébastien Robicquet, the founder of Maison Villevert, and Aël Guegan, the Distiller and Cellar Master for the Celtic Whisky Distillerie have selected then combined the complexity of a Scotch whisky with the character of a German whisky and the finesse of French single malts from our distillery.

Slowly diluted with water from the distillery's source, Gwalarn is a complex, authentic and bold blend that is part of the Celtic Whisky Distillerie's collection of exceptional French whiskies.

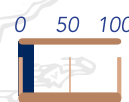
